


We are hoping to have someone show us round the gardens but this is yet to be confirmed.

PORTFOLIO

The award winning entries and a selection of the best entries in each class will be made into a travelling portfolio and circulated to member societies during the period September 2022 to May 2023.

PHOTOFOLIO 2022 IMPORTANT CHANGE IN RULES

At last Saturdays MCPF Council Meeting it was decided to update and simplify the rules for this years PHOTOFOLIO.

All clubs can now enter up to a MAXIMUM of 15 images in each of the three classes, Mono Prints, Colour, Prints and Projected Images.

To qualify for the club championship in each class clubs will need to enter 15 images.

If a smaller number of images are entered any of the individual awards can be still won.

It should be remembered tat as any one photographer can enter up to 4 images per class. So only 4 photographers are needed to produce the 15 images required for the Championship in each Class.

Please find attached the updated rules.

The Entry system opens on April 7th through the MCPF website.
