

### **Camera Club Visit to Middleport Pottery, Stoke on Trent - Thursday 10th November.**

Middleport Pottery is a working pottery which makes Burleigh Ware amongst other designs, including pottery for our new King Charles' estate shops.

Their factory tour is superb, some of our members went previously in 2017 and it's well worth a second trip. They take you through all the pottery making process and the staff are more than happy to pose for photographs.

In addition to the factory tour we will also do their Heritage Trail which includes the Victorian Offices, Steam Engine, Grade 2 Listed bottle kiln, bath house and Europe's largest design archive.

There are steps and uneven floors but I don't think anyone will have a problem getting around.

This part of the day will begin mid morning at a cost of £13 per head (but if there are enough of us there will be a 10% discount).

Lunch will be at the Pottery and will be Staffordshire Lobby, which is a Beef Stew plus hot roll and tea or coffee (vegetarian equivalent on request). The cost for this is approx £10.50.

So total cost is a maximum of £23.50 per head including food (plus parking - I need to check parking costs).

After lunch we will drive down to the canal in the Etruria area which is about 15 minutes away. It's an interesting historic site which includes the Etruscan Bone and Flint Mill, interesting canal buildings, a really deep lock, Bedford staircase lock and a Statue of James Brindley. This area is the junction of the Trent and Mersey Canal and the Caldon Canal. I expect to leave for home around 3.30pm.

If you would like to go on the trip please email Carole on [carole-perry@sky.com](mailto:carole-perry@sky.com) and pay Mary £5 non refundable deposit on Monday 24th October. We will also need to know whether you are having lunch (and if you want the vegetarian option).

Maximum number for the trip is 12 as usual.
