JCB lakes visit sunday 19th February.

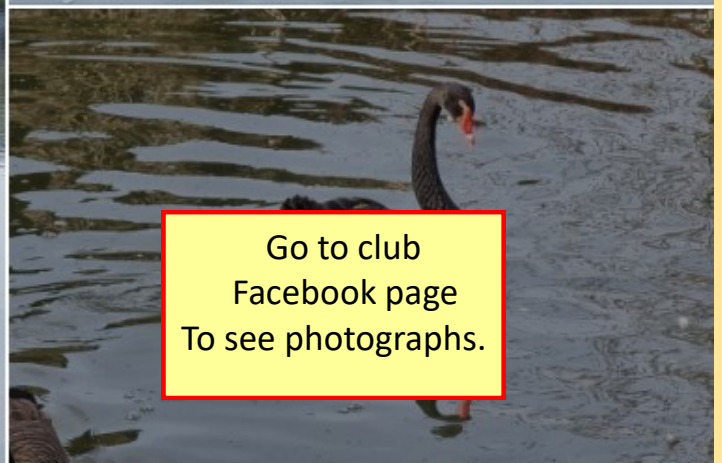
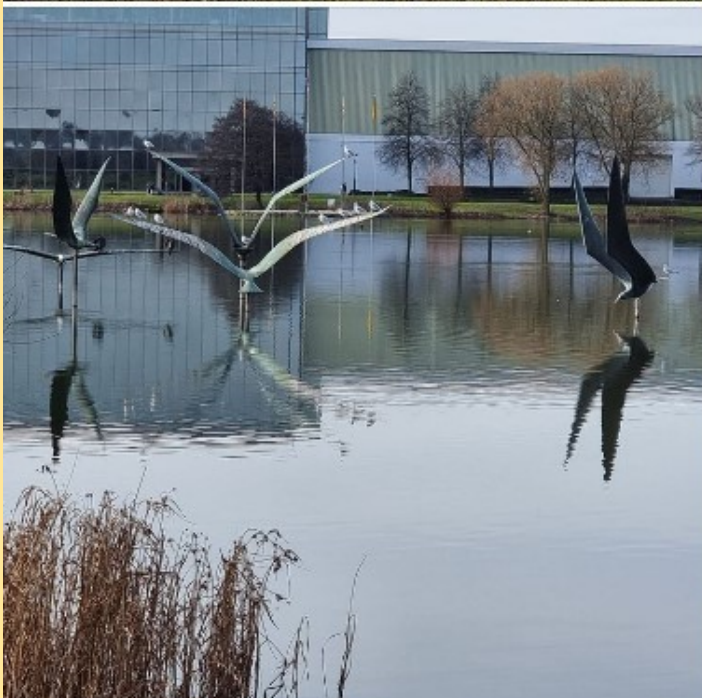
