> on their camera's. New members were asking for advice, which is what these evenings are all about.







Free Magazines through the Library. Article by Steve Moore.

Do you want some free magazines every month? You can if you are a member of your local library. If you are not a member you can join for free! Once you have a library membership number simply download and install the "Libby Library" app from the App Store on Apple or Google Play on Android. It's best installed on a tablet because it's easier to read but works well on a phone. Log in with your Library membership number and the name of your Library. Then search for say "photography" or "cycling" or "knitting" or whatever your passion and it gives you a list of magazines to choose from. There is no limit on how many you can subscribe to, but the latest monthly edition you download expires after a month. You can also search back editions. You can either stream them or download them in advance to your device to read off line. Always download them if you are going on an aircraft, because streaming doesn't work! If there are more than one column on a page it gives you the option to view each article in turn. Also



you can zoom in on the screen, something you can't do with a physical magazine! I've never seen this advertised anywhere and a lot of people aren't aware of it. Try it for free and we all love free! Any problems just ask, Steve Moore.
